Emerald Village Eugene — APPLICATION PACKET—

Emerald Village Eugene (EVE) is now accepting applications. Please read the following before completing the application. Tours will only be given to the applicant called, please do not disturb the village or tenants.

Who we are: Emerald Village Eugene is a housing cooperative dedicated to providing simple, affordable housing in a community setting. This is different from conventional rental housing. EVE is not simply a cheap place to live. EVE's Members manage the property in a cooperative and democratic manner. In addition to paying monthly carrying carrying charges (rent), Members are required to:

- Contribute 10 hours per month toward the maintenance, management, and upkeep of the property
- Participate in monthly General Membership Meetings and follow EVE's decision-making process
- Participate in the work of at least one of EVE's committees

Membership at EVE offers the opportunity to learn new skills and participate in democratic decision making. During its first year of operation, EVE members will be involved in developing, implementing, and troubleshooting co-op policies and procedures.

Income eligibility: In order for your application to be considered, your household must meet the following income requirements:

Documentation of income is required with your application

Be sure to check the listing for the unit you are applying for to make sure your household size is within the occupancy limits.

<u>Selection criteria</u>: Applications will be reviewed via lottery. Applications selected in the lottery will be reviewed for completeness and according to the following criteria:

- 1. Income eligibility: household meets the income guidelines above
- 2. Community agreements: Each household applicant must demonstrate the ability to live in accordance with the various agreements and policies adopted by EVE, to participate in the day to day life and governance of EVE in a cooperative manner, and to fulfill the obligations required of all co-op members. Evidence of this will be sought during reference checks, in reviewing information provided in the application, and during the interview process.
- **3.** Background check: Each household applicant must accurately report any and all criminal convictions as verified by a background check. Applicants with a history of violent or sexual offenses will require additional screening.
- **4.** References: Applicant has at least 3 positive personal references and at least 1 positive rental or transitional housing reference (e.g. from Opportunity Village, Community Supported Shelters, etc.). References should be able to verify applicant's ability to fulfill co-op obligations (including paying carrying charges on time); and to work cooperatively and reliably with groups. References may not be relatives.
- **5.** Interview: Selected applicant(s) who have passed the background check and had their references checked will be interviewed by a meeting of the General Membership, and will be notified of a decision the following day.

Applicants approved for membership must make a non-refundable \$50 membership fee payment within 72 hours of being notified of acceptance, and begin paying carrying charges (rent) within 30 days. An additional \$150 payment toward the membership fee must be paid upon move-in.


How to submit your application:

-Community Agreements-

The vision for Emerald Village Eugene (EVE) is to provide accessible and sustainable housing options for people with low-incomes through tiny houses that are safe, livable, and significantly more affordable within a stable community setting.

Costs are kept low through an emphasis on small-scale development, self-management, and cooperative living. But an application to become a member of EVE is more than just a cheap place to live. It includes your participation in shaping how your housing is managed and maintained through a democratic process.

I understand that this is different from typical rental housing, and that living at EVE comes with additional obligations beyond a monthly payment. If accepted, I agree to:

• Participate in monthly Village Meetings to discuss matters of common interest and make collective decisions.

• **Contribute at least 10 volunteer hours per month** toward the maintenance, upkeep, and management of the property. This includes signing up for designated roles for maintaining common areas, leading community improvement projects, or helping plan activities and other jobs that need to be shared.

Each member is expected to participate in at least one of the primary committees, and assist that committee in doing the work necessary to maintain the Village as a safe, presentable, and pleasant place to live.

- Membership Committee: applications & intake, community participation review, dispute review
- House & Grounds Committee: maintenance and improvements of physical assets
- Administration Committee: administrative tasks, budgeting, finance
- OFEC: Outreach, Fundraising & Events Coordination, vending for community microbusiness

Furthermore, if accepted as a member of EVE, I agree to the following:

1. I will respect others regardless of ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, disability, lifestyle choices, or economic status.

2. I agree to participate in the day-to-day life and governance of the Village in a cooperative manner, act in accordance with EVE's bylaws, and observe all adopted co-op policies.

3. I will not act violently toward others or myself.

4. I will not use illegal drugs at the Village, and will not consume alcohol in common areas unless approved by the Village in advance.

5. I will respect the smoking policy, the guest policy, and honor quiet hours and restrictions on amplified noise.

6. I will honor all pet policies, and understand that only a limited number of pets may be allowed and that a pet deposit may be required.

7. I will keep the area in and around where I live clean and orderly, and not store any personal items outside of my unit or in common areas.

8. I understand that the space outside my dwelling will be a shared resource, and will honor all policies for community areas. I will help keep the community areas clean and will pick up after myself, and my pet if I have one.

9. I understand that the EVE property is leased from SquareOne Villages, and will honor all policies outlined in the Management & Lease Agreement.
